The review of your research proposal by a scientific expert in the area of your proposal is a critical step in the proposal review process. Scholars and their mentors should best know the expertise needed for a meaningful review. Scholars are advised to discuss potential reviewers with their mentor before listing below a minimum of three potential reviewers of their proposal. CCaTS will reach out to these reviewers to seek their willingness to conduct the proposal review.

These potential reviewers must be employed by Mayo Clinic and cannot be proposed Thesis Advisory Committee (TAC) members <u>or</u> co-authors on manuscripts/publications that will be part of the scholar's master's research project/thesis. Potential reviewers must have scientific expertise in the area of the research proposal. Information for three potential reviewers is required. Additional names are helpful if other reviewers proposed are unable to conduct the review.
